EMS Willfully Infringes Peach State Labs Patent

ROME, GEORGIA (April 19) – A US District Court for Middle District of Florida jury has found that **Environmental Manufacturing Solutions (EMS)** willfully infringed on **Peach State Labs, Inc's.** method for using **urea hydrochloride** (patent 5,672,279). The jury reached a verdict on Monday, April 18 in the matter which was filed in 2009 -- *Environmental Manufacturing Solutions, LLC v. Peach State Labs, Inc.*, Case No. 6:09-CV-395.

Urea hydrochloride is an industrial chemical that dissolves water insoluble calcium carbonate to make it water soluble. EMS products affected by the verdict's outcome include: EMS Ready Mix Truck Wash and Wax, EMS Barracuda, EMS Basic CR, EMS BlowOut, EMS SynTech pH, and EMS Eximo.

Peach State Labs, Inc. will be pursuing a permanent injunction and other relief.
